1. NIXI Overview

The National Internet Exchange of India (hereinafter referred to as 'NIXI' or 'Purchaser') is a Not-for Profit Company registered under Section 25 of the Indian Companies Act, 1956 (now Section 8 under Companies Act, 2013) with the primary objective of facilitating improved Internet services in the country.

Key Functions of NIXI

Internet Exchange:

NIXI is the neutral meeting point of the ISPs in India. Its main purpose is to facilitate exchange of domestic Internet traffic between the peering ISP members. This enables more efficient use of international bandwidth, saving foreign exchange. It also improves the Quality of Services for the customers of member ISPs, by avoiding multiple international hops and thus reducing latency.

Nine Internet Nodes are functional at Delhi (Noida), Mumbai (two nodes), Chennai, Kolkata, Hyderabad, Bengaluru, Ahmedabad and Guwahati.

Internet nodes have ensured peering of ISPs among themselves for routing domestic Internet traffic within India, resulting in better quality of service (reduced latency, reduced bandwidth charges for ISPs) saving on international bandwidth

.IN Registry

- Under NIXI, the .IN Registry functions as an autonomous body with primary responsibility for maintaining the .IN & Bharat (IDN) Country code top level domain (ccTLD) and ensuring its operational stability, reliability, and security.
- .IN Registry functions with primary responsibility for managing Country Code Top Level Domains (ccTLDs).
- Registration of .IN domain has crossed the 2.4 million mark in December 2020. Presently, 138 Registrars have been accredited to offer .IN domain name registration worldwide to customers. It has helped in proliferation of web hosting and promotion of Internet usage in the country.
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National Internet Registry (NIR)

Coordinates Internet Protocol address space (both IPv4, IPv6 & ASN allocations and other internet resource management functions at a national level within the country. Earlier NIR was recognized by APNIC (Asia Pacific Network Information Centre) which is a Regional Internet Registry.

Since its launch in 2012, NIR has registered impressive growth, the number of affiliates registered are approx. 3000 as on November, 2020.

- domain name in Devanagari script was successfully launched on August 27, 2014
- In next phase the general availability of IDN in Gujarati, Bengali, Manipuri in Bengali script, Punjabi, Tamil, Telugu & Urdu language started from August 3rd, 2015
- Now IDN domains can be booked in any of the 22 official Indian languages.
- IDN will increase the penetration of internet through use of local languages and local content

2. Purpose:

National Internet Exchange Of India (NIXI) desires to contribute towards “Digital Village” scheme of Government of India to provide internet access to the villages.

In this connection, NIXI invites bid for below requirement:

- Purchasing of Thin client Device, Multimedia Projector, External Storage device and related networking as per attached specification (Annexure-03). There is an urgent requirement of ICT Labs to be established in schools. This is pilot project where the equipment is to be installed and maintained at 35 schools, based on performance the further decision would be taken. The no. can be increased/ decreased based on final requirement.
- The supply and warranty is to be given ON SITE as per the list of address attached (Annexure -06).
- Display Cabling, Virtualization software loading and other client specific application loading is part of the scope of supply and installation of the Thin client devices.
- Only one agency will be identified for the supply of all the items in required quantity as per this tender.
- Preventive maintenance support to be provided on site for both hardware and software for 3 years from the date of installation.
- Agencies authorized by Thin client devices OEM and engaged in the sales/supply of Thin client devices are eligible to quote for this tender.
- Submit Authorization from Manufacturer (Thin client devices) stating that the products are covered under OEM warranty for a period of 3 years from the date of supply. 3-year warranty confirmation (mentioning serial number of each device) to be provided by OEM prior to the delivery. Warranty Certificate from System Integrator/ Distributor or any other party will not be accepted. Please

confirm in the bid clearly that the warranty of the supplied hardware is 3 years from the OEM Thin client devices. NIXI may verify the 3 year warranty coverage at any stage of the evaluation from Thin client devices OEM.

- The agency must have supplied Thin client devices Zero client in government organization/ PSU/Government Undertaking. Provide copy of at least one purchase order from Government Organization/PSU for the supply of Thin client devices.

3. Extent of Proposal:

Prospective vendor should note that any proposal submitted in response to this RFP and all associated amendments or clarifications submitted during evaluation, would form part of any subsequent contract to be signed for the services relating to the Project.

FOLLOWING IS THE DETAILED TENDER AS WELL AS DRAFT AGREEMENT OF THE PROJECT -

The Contract Price includes payment for the supply of all labour (including payment to his Sub-Contractors), equipment, materials, plant and machinery, tools, transportation, framework, scaffolding, works under this Bid and any/all applicable taxes including but not limited to the duties, octroi, levies, royalties, fees, insurance premiums, contributions towards employees benefits including ESI and PF and funds, and all services and activities constituting the Scope of Work as per BOQ. The above stated Contract Price is including the GST. The Contract Price also includes the Contractor's

establishment, infrastructure, overheads & profits and all other charges, and shall generally be inclusive of every cost and expense required by the Contract to be borne by the Contractor and necessary for the proper execution and completion of the Work under the Contract, in conformity with the Contract Documents and the best engineering and construction practices and to the satisfaction of the Engineer, Architect, and the Employer. Wherever it is provided in the Conditions of Contract, Specifications, and other Contract Documents that the Contractor shall perform certain work or provide certain facilities, it is understood that the Contractor shall do so at his own cost, unless otherwise provided in the Documents.

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRACT:

1. You are requested to start mobilizing resources for the project immediately after formal PO. The work shall be completed within **45 days** reckoned from the date of issue of this agreement, the completion date being **28th Feb, 2021**. The entire work shall be carried out by you in accordance with the conditions and specifications stipulated in the tender documents issued to you and as per working drawings, which will be issued to you in a phased manner as the work progresses.
2. The Site Manager or such other person as may be designated from time to time, shall be the designated Engineer for this project and NIXI shall contact him for possession of site, commencement of work, and other details for the project.
3. Insurance: You shall within 15 days, provide all insurances as per relevant clauses of the contract including CAR Policy, third party insurance, Workmen compensation policy and any other as listed in the tender document.
4. You shall execute into a separate indemnity bond with you being the Employer stating that all responsibility of safety at site lies with you as per terms mentioned herewith.
6. **NIXI** reserves the right to increase or decrease the scope of the Work on any or all items or to completely delete any items of the Work under the Contract. You shall not be entitled to claim for increased overheads, loss of anticipated profits, for mobilization of additional resources, or for any other such reason on account of these change orders. The individual quantities of items as well as the total contract sum may vary to any extent, positive or negative and the rates would remain firm, fixed and binding on you on account of these variations.
7. A detailed phased construction programme of work including supply of material, keeping in view the completion period should be prepared by you and submitted to the Engineer or approval in three days of receipt of this

agreement. The contractor shall also submit and get approved from the Engineer, site logistics plan for smooth operations.

8. You shall arrange to deploy all equipment and material provided for in the tender document and as agreed during the negotiations. You shall increase resources, manpower etc. as required by the Engineer to keep in pace and complete the work in given time schedule.
9. If you fail to maintain the required progress or to complete the work as per stipulated timelines and clear the site on or before the contract or extended date of completion, you shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy available under the law to the Government on account of such breach, pay as agreed compensation, to the Employer

For every week of delay the contractor shall be liable to pay liquidated damages at the following rate 0.1% of the contract value per day subject to a maximum of 10% of the contract value.

10. The Defects Liability period shall mean a period of 36 months reckoned from the certified date of virtual completion/taking over of the works or in the event of more than one certificate, from the respective dates so certified by the Engineer. During the defect liability period the contractor must ensure whenever required, sufficient deployment of staff along with required material, tools, tackles, plant, equipment etc. as may be deemed fit by the Engineer.
11. You shall submit the bills as per work contract management system (WCMS)/any other approved system in soft copy (excel format) as well as hard copy, as per approved Performa. The date of receipt of bill shall be considered as the date when the bill has been received in the proper format, along with all necessary supporting documents
12. Quality, along with the time is the essence of this project. The work has to be done to the utmost quality standards, and all works shall be free from all latent/visible defects and deficiencies. You shall ensure that the work to be carried out should be as per specifications in the contract document and shall have first class workmanship. In the event if the quality of workmanship, materials or standard for work is not in accordance to the contract or not to the satisfaction of our Architects and Project Manager, we shall have the right, without prejudice to our rights which we may have under any law for the time being in force, to terminate the contract forthwith and get the work redone/rectified at your cost, expense and consequence and you shall be liable to the Employer for any losses, damages, costs or expenses whatsoever that may be incurred by us in this regard.
13. The Contractor shall, at all times when requested, satisfy the Engineer by the production of records or books or submissions of returns that the materials

are being used for the purpose for which they are procured and the Contractor shall at all times keep the records updated to enable the Engineer to apply such checks as he may desire to impose. The Contractor shall, at all times, permit the Engineer to inspect his godown. The Contractor shall not, without prior written permission of the Engineer, utilize or dispose of the materials for any purpose other than intended in the Contract.

14. In any emergency affecting the safety of persons or property, you shall act, at your discretion and responsibility to prevent the threatened damage, injury or loss, but at the same time safeguarding the interest of client in the interest of Project.
15. All the contractual provisions in the document regarding environment, health and safety precautions as well as model rules are one of the prime objectives of this project and must be considered as sacrosanct.
16. Bank Guarantee: 5% of value of PO to be submitted at the time of agreement as per format to be provided by NIXI.
17. This letter shall be construed in accordance with the Laws of India and the Courts at New Delhi shall have exclusive jurisdiction. Any dispute or difference arising under or in connection with it shall be resolved by arbitration in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The arbitration shall be held at Delhi and the proceedings shall be in English Language. The arbitral award shall be final and binding on the parties.
18. In the event of any ambiguity, this agreement letter shall supersede all other correspondence and conditions of contract. This shall form a binding contract between parties.
19. You are requested to acknowledge the receipt and confirm the acceptance of this agreement within two days from the date of the receipt of this letter.
